We believe in the equal value of every human being and the importance of respecting and honoring each individual; we know that change happens through people.

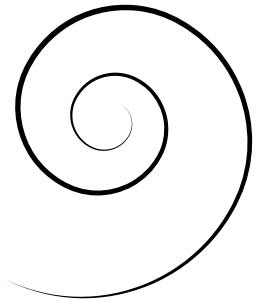
Mandate

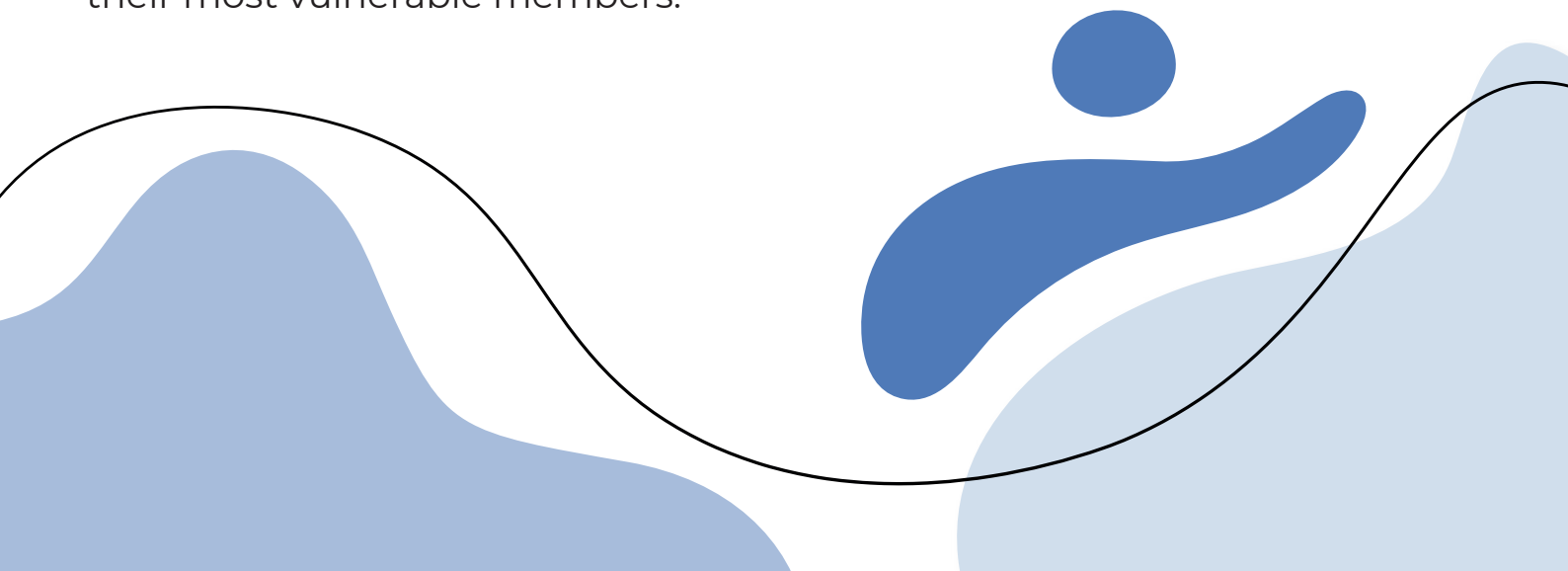
Why Borderless Adopts a Community-Based Protection and Development Approach?



Our experience has shown that effective support can only be achieved in close partnership with the communities.

It is premised on the basis that communities and marginalized groups are often better placed to identify their most critical problems and know how best to resolve them. By being able to better protect and develop themselves and their communities, they also become less dependent on external aid.

In turn, their actions contribute to building healthier communities which better protect and look after their most vulnerable members.

Growth Timeline

2015

Year of Launch

Borderless started in 2015 with local initiatives after mapping out the programs required to support the marginalized communities in Lebanon

2017

Official Registration

The organization was officially registered as an NGO in 2017 and started delivering non-formal education to children in Beirut, Lebanon

2018

Year of Collaborations

Borderless established relationships with other NGOs and entities through collaboration on projects and activities to serve 240 Children, 120 Youth and 160 women.

2019

Community Flourishment

After an impactful year through development programs and activities, borderless served 560 children, 240 youth and 320 women.

2020

Year of Expansion

After Beirut explosion, Borderless responded and set up a community center in Karantina to run relief programs and activities. More than 600 children and 320 women were served post the blast. Ouzai center continued delivery of programs and activities.

2021

Program Development

The focus was on enhancing the NGO processes and policies to ensure scalable operations. New mental health programs and youth development programs were also successfully launched.

Year of Growth

The NGO's presence in both Ouzai and Karantina continues to grow, and we are seeking partners & funds to expand our existing capacity as well as expand geographically to serve more communities in Lebanon.
